



# *Nicolai Fechin*

*The work of Nicolai Fechin, 1881-1955, is filled with profound human meanings. His people live — the anonymous Indians, Javanese, Chinese, and the Negroes that he drew and painted in their native lands — as well as the celebrated personalities of our country who sat for him in his Santa Monica studio. . .*

*Thoroughly trained in the tradition of art, Fechin added his own power and dexterity to that tradition, developing a rich, personal style and a wondrous control that allowed him complete freedom in selecting subjects for his canvas. His interests were boundless; ethnological subjects were a principal theme he first discovered in his native Russia when he drew the colorful Mongol peoples of Siberia, and which found its highest expression in his portrayal of the Indians and Spaniards around Santa Fe and Taos where he lived for more than a decade.*
