MARIA HELENA ANDRES is among Brazilian artists following the abstract trend in painting. Born in the city of Belo Horizonte in 1922, she received her first training at the local art school from the celebrated Alberto da Veiga Guignard; later she studied in Rio de Janeiro with Carlos Chaurbellard. Individual exhibitions of her work were presented in Belo Horizonte in 1953, 1954, 1955, and 1959; at the Brazilian-American Cultural Institute of Rio in 1954; and at the Piccola Gallery in the same city last year. Miss Andres participated in four of the São Paulo biennials as well as in numerous salons held throughout Brazil, at which she received several awards. Compositions by her have been included in group shows of Brazilian painting which have circulated in Latin America and Europe, and examples of her work are to be found in the National Museum of Fine Arts, in Rio and in many private collections in her native country. She has taught at the School of Fine Arts in Belo Horizonte, and this year she came to the United States on a museum tour, at the invitation of the Department of State. During her travels she visited the Museum of New Mexico and arrangements were made for this showing of her work. This marks the second exhibition of Miss Andres' paintings in the United States.

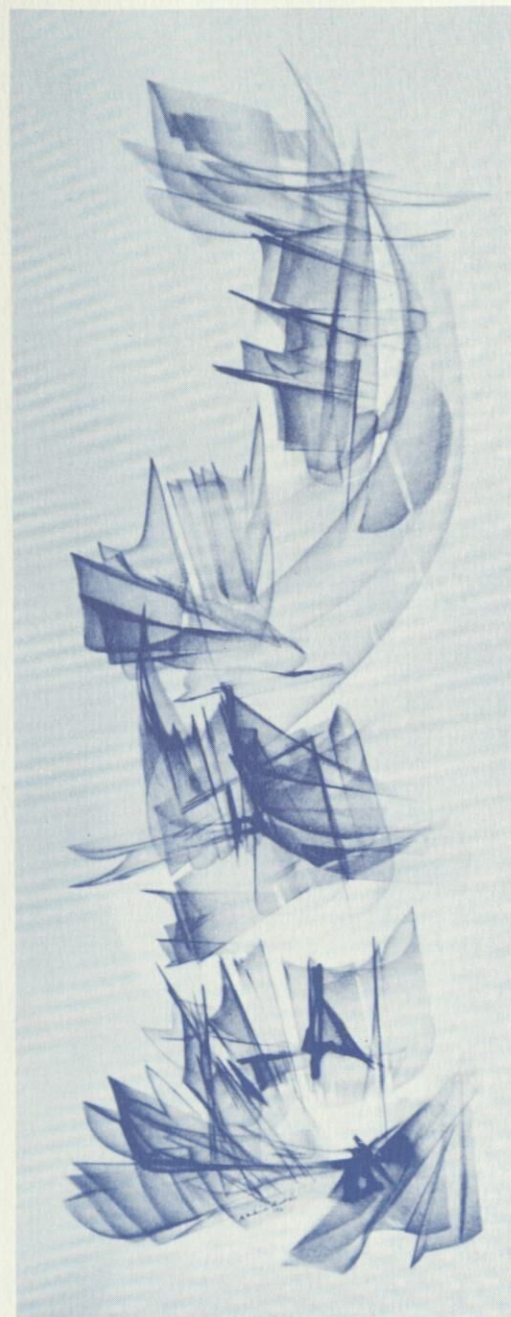
